Where:

The vineyards are nestled in the O Salnés Valley, a prime subregion of Rías Baixas in Galicia, Spain, known for its proximity to the Atlantic Ocean. This coastal influence, combined with the region's cool climate, helps produce exceptionally fresh and aromatic wines. The soil is well-drained and mineral-rich, preventing waterlogging and allowing the cultivation of high-quality, refined grapes. Each grape is carefully hand-picked at optimal ripeness before being gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel tanks under controlled temperatures, preserving the wine's crisp acidity and vibrant fruit character.
