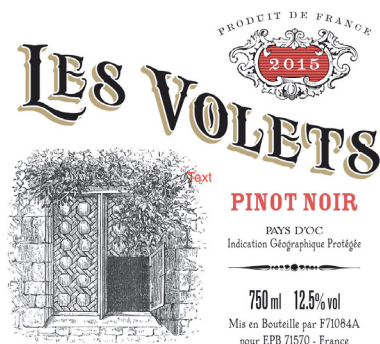

What:

“Les Volets” translates to “shutters”. The kind of window shutter you find on almost every house in the south of France. As the shutters are absolutely typical of the villages of the Haute Vallée de l'Aude, so too are these wines completely expressive of the region.

Where:

Separated from the Mediterranean by a range of coastal mountains whose elevation and gradient prompt higher diurnal ranges and allow cool winds from the Atlantic to blow through the vines. The region's climate resembles South-West France more than the other hot, dry coastal areas of Languedoc. The wine is unoaked to maintain a pure, refined elegance and varietal character of Pinot Noir.

Food Pairings:

Delicious both with and without food; try with a herby sausage casserole, grilled lamb or pea and ham soup.

Tasting Note:

Ruby red with upfront aromas of freshly-picked raspberries and an underlying savory note with delicate spice. The palate is fleshy with red fruit, fine tannins and juicy acidity. A serious Pinot Noir
