As delightful to the palate as the countryside is to the eyes, Beaujolais can only come from one of the most picturesque 'quartiers' of France: home-grown in the valleys and hills folded between Mâcon and Lyon in central eastern France.

Where:

The Gamay vines used for this wine are grown on the slopes of the rolling Beaujolais hills. We select from different producers who, through various wine making decisions (using whole bunches or destemming, full or semi-carbonic maceration) bring particular elements to the wine which are blended to make what we consider to be a classic Beaujolais.
