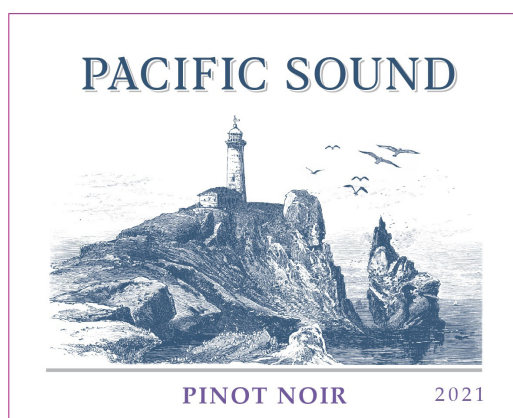
## Where:

The grapes come from the field Los Monos located south of Curico, on the border of the Claro River. In the winery the grapes are Gently destemmed, a cold maceration is carried out at a temperature of 8 to 10o C for 3 days, then Fermentation is carried out with selected yeasts for 5 to 7 days with temperature ranging close to 25oC. Finally, 50% of the wine remains in contact with French wood the other 50% of the blend remains in stain stell in order to maintain freshness and vibrant acidity.
