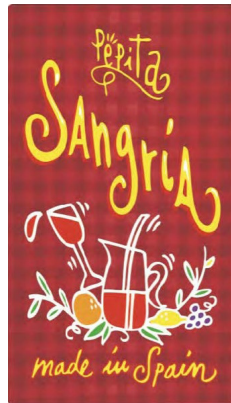
What:

The grapes are fermented in the traditional way to make wine and then an infusion of natural citrus essences are added with a touch of spice to add an exotic touch. Pepita's smooth, sweetness comes from the addition of sugar made from the juice of grapes.
